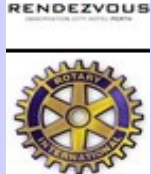
**Senior First Aid Course this Saturday!!**

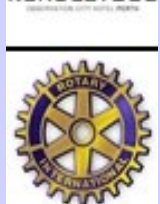
