### WA Surf League Rd 2 Wrap Up

It was with great excitement that we saw Scarboro field two stand-alone teams at WA Surf League Rd 2 on 12th January. After not fielding a team last season, Scarboro Black & Scarboro Gold finished 7th & 15th overall respectively. Scarboro Black narrowly missed out on a top-six finish, 2pts behind Secret Harbour & 13pts behind City of Perth Red.

To put this in perspective, the top five teams in the overall points score were made up of City of Perth (1st & 5th), Trigg (2nd & 3rd), & North Cottesloe A (4th). This means we are most certainly heading in the right direction to start contending with the three big clubs who have dominated competition in recent years.

It was a great atmosphere under the two tents as our competitors from all disciplines came together to watch & support each other. A big thanks to all those involved, especially to Warren Jones for all the work he has done with our Youth & Open competitors. Thanks also goes to the Masters competitors who came out of retirement to compete strongly against other clubs' Open competitors and also bolster our numbers, allowing us to field two teams rather than just one.
