Another hot topic around the Club is the lack of external signage identifying our buildings as Scarboro SLSC. As part of the foreshore redevelopment process the City of Stirling and Scarboro SLSC agreed to building signage, including the size, content and location with the Metropolitan Redevelopment Authority and we received development approval to proceed. Subsequently the City has changed their mind on the size, content and location of the already approved signage, so now we are up to version 4 with no definitive end in sight as anything the Board agrees to still must have City and MRA approval. I’d like to think this matter will be resolved before Aussies 2022 return to Scarborough Beach but having put the brakes on us in September 2018 we are still waiting on the City to progress the matter.

Congratulations to our competitors who took part in the third and final round of the Surf League on Sunday delivering another set of solid results for Scarboro.
