Congratulations to our Nippers who competed last weekend and have qualified for Junior State Titles. As the home beach for both Junior and Senior State Titles I can’t wait to see our members competing over the coming weekends.

Whilst our Nippers had their chance to compete on the weekend the rest of the Club wasn’t left out as **Brian Hall** lined our members up for the annual Club Championship events. Suffice to say that the conditions on the Sunday threw up a few curly waves that challenged a number of our competitors in the surf. Thanks to Brian and his team of starters, finishers and record keepers for their help in making this Club event happen. I sadly didn’t get to make the Club Champs having other commitments on the Sunday so it looks like I’ll be presenting the towels and not receiving one this year ☹️.

Saturday saw a number of members take on the Rottneest Channel Swim for 2019, well done to those who made it as solo, duo or teams. It was great to see our members head up the finish chute and over the line after all their efforts cheered on by their Club mates from Scarboro SLSC. As a Club we provide the water safety for swimmers on the final stretch after their support boat and then paddler peel away on the final approach.

Having reached us after 19km most swimmers have a few hundred metres left before they stand up and cross the line, given how far they have come at this point most push through with gritty steel and determination to have their moment of glory and reflection. Saturday presented a number of challenges for the water safety team from Scarboro not least a full resuscitation of a swimmer who went unconscious in those final few hundred metres. As the first responder on scene all my training kicked in after the initial few seconds of shock and I was ably backed up by **Jacinta Waters** and **Dylan Aeisi** who came to my aid in the IRB. Our speed of intervention, hand off to advanced medical support and the patient’s determination not to give up without a fight has seen her pull through.
