Aussies Gold Coast 2019

The Aussies kicked off at North Burleigh for the Youth Championships on Saturday 30th March with a fair bit of swell and rain all day. The cans were set inside the outer bank and the occasional set rolled through from out the back, even tipping an IRB. There were some nerves but **Riley Somers, Alice Harwood and Phoebe Jones** all raced well and got through some heats. The best result was **Alice** 13th in the U14 surf race. The next day was kinder and **Riley** dominated the 2km beach run until the final few metres and finished 2nd with daylight to third. A superb and gutsy run at his first Australian titles. **Phoebe** ran well to finish in 7th. **Alice** went down to Burleigh for the 2km ocean swim and after a delayed start due to a "marine creature" sighting swam well and finished 7th. The girls combined for the U15 board rescue and had a win in their heat (beating the eventual gold medallists) but were unlucky in their next round.



Next it was the Masters at Broadbeach for **Jose Desfosses** and **myself**. There was a medium swell with a strengthening southerly and a strong side current. I managed to spot the cans in the rising sun before the others and got a win in the board race then 2nd in the surf race and 4th in the ironman. **Jose** got a great start in the ski and headed straight into a set which split his ski and ended his race. He made it through a few rounds of the beach sprint. The next day he made amends with a dominant win in the 1km beach run and backed it up with 7th in the beach flags.

The swell doubled for the next 2 days and after many postponed races the women and U17 males were shifted to North Kirra. Those still racing at Broadbeach battled the swell, much to the delight of the spectators. Sometimes you needed a bit of luck just to get out and then a set would roll over the ski cans! *Carnage described some races well.*

We had 3 U17 runners: **Ben Johnson, Zac Coleman and Hannah Jones**, competing in the 2km beach run on Thursday along with **Jose** backing up in the open 2km. **Ben** and **Zac** both had great races with **Ben** just overtaking another runner before the line and claiming third and **Zac** overtaking 9 runners over the last 500m to claim 6th. Hannah was in a tight bunch of 4 runners with 300m to go and finished well to claim a close second. Jose fronted up for the long run with the young guns and ran superbly finishing 9th. An outstanding result for a man old enough to be the other competitor's grandfather!

Scarboro's long beach run results speak for themselves, 6 competitors- 1 gold, 2 silver, 1 bronze, 6th, 7th and 9th. An amazing effort at a National level and competing against track runners with paid professional coaches. Great running and thanks Jose.

[Aussies next year are back to the Gold Coast with dates still pending, it's a great experience and I'd encourage everyone to be a part of it, especially the U14/U15 Youth championships.](#)



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
