Speaking of Friday, after the short Easter and ANZAC closure the bar will be re-opening this Friday from 5pm for drinks. I'll be down from 5pm to start off my weekend and look forward to seeing our members and their friends there too.

Sunday saw competition of old and new along the coast. At Scarborough, we hosted a reunion of the Scarboro R&R State Teams from 1959 and 1956 courtesy of Wally Fry, along with a have a go surf boat session for John XXIII school which has seen some 75 students come through the club in recent weeks to find out more about surf life saving and have a go in a surf boat.

A short distance up the coast at Trigg I was at the IRB Racing Series Round #2 for a great day of racing seeing Scarboro represented in 10 of the 11 finals, 9 of which we took out at least one podium position! 39 of our 60 points were achieved by girl-power, on par with the 38 brought in by the girls teams in Round #1. The male single saw our teams cross the line in a photo finish for 2nd & 3rd, and it was arguably closer in the female mass with the girls taking 1st & 2nd! The female single was by far the stand-out race of the day, with the girls taking out 1st, 2nd, 4th & 6th, racking up 15 of the 21 available points in that race (a quarter of our total point score!)

Although A and B grades swam together this week, with everybody off go, The Handicapper has announced the results for their respective divisions:

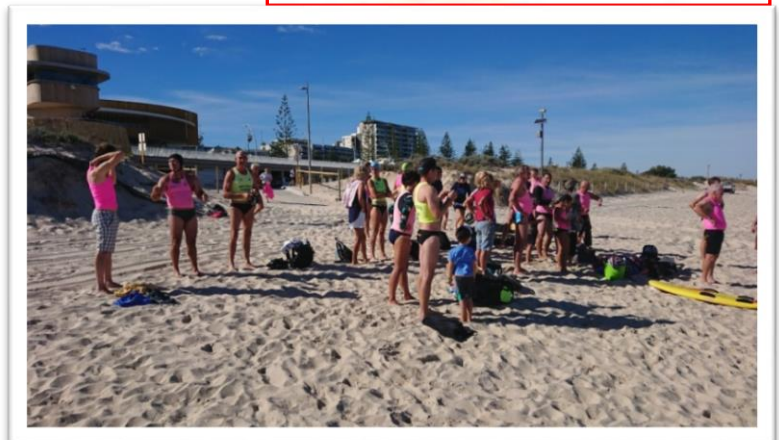
