Rain Jacket (Fleece lining): \$87.00+gst

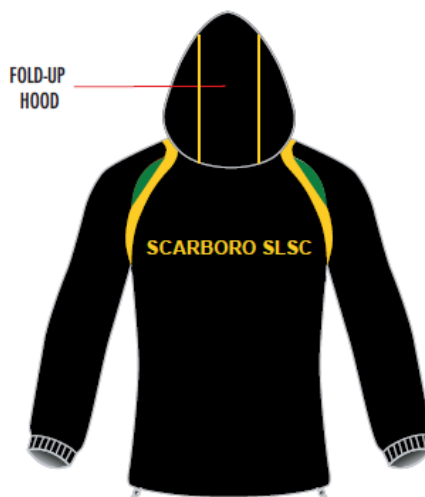
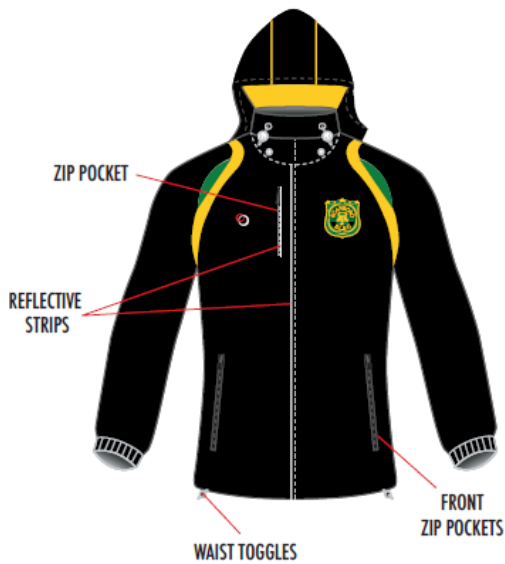
Bench Jacket: \$120.00+gst

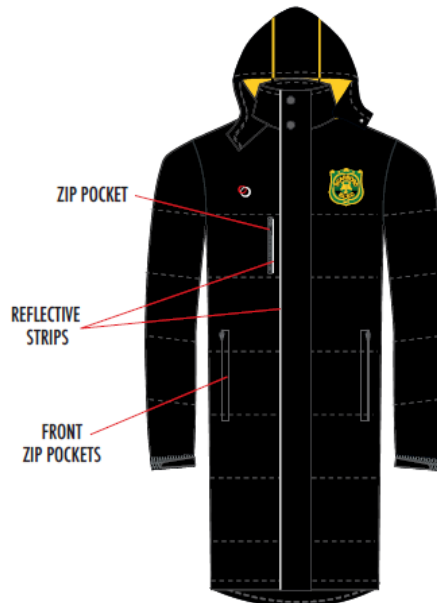
