To date, our volunteer lifesavers have patrolled nearly 7,700 hours, completed 196 rescues and assisted with over 260 first aid case, no small feat for our 200 active lifesavers!

Sadly, our Woodside Nippers, Starfish Nippers and Surf Sports seasons were cut short much to the disappointment of our members. As frustrating as it was for those members and the wider movement not to finish their season, clearly it was the right thing to do.

As a Board, we continue to monitor the ever-changing situation and advice from the relevant authorities and will make changes to our operations accordingly. At present our changerooms remain open to members and the office remains open for online and telephone enquiries only. The most important piece of advice coming out at the moment is the importance of physical (social) distancing. As the graph below shows the less we interact and the more we stay at home and away from other people the sooner we can get on top of this.

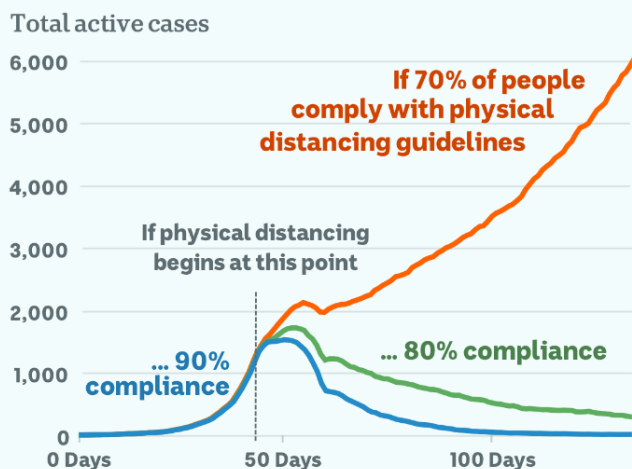

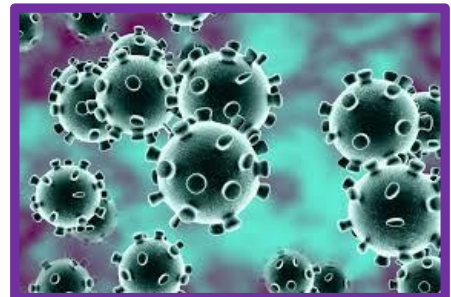
