Board training has started up on Sunday's at 3pm at Peppermint Grove beach.

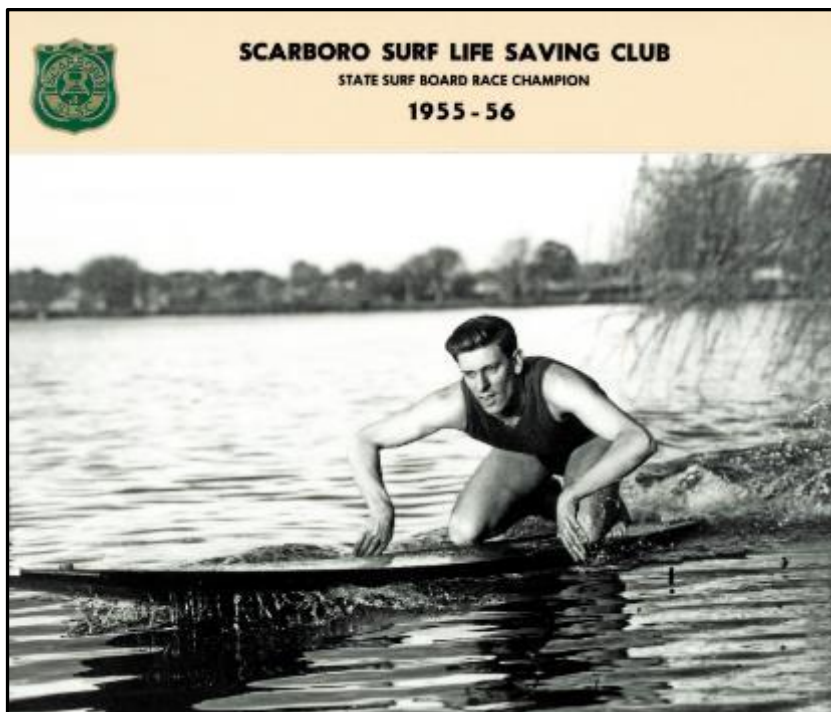
Grant will send out info regarding Ski paddling for beginners, looks like paddling will return to Saturdays (watch this space for a commencement date.)
