With a limited capacity, tickets will surely sell out fast so keep an eye open for the announcement of the event and ticket sales in due course.

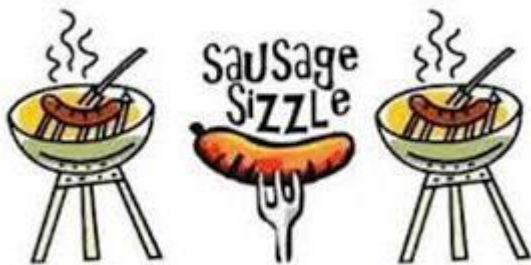
I will be heading down south for a weekend away but will be back down the Club in a week to see you on the beach.
