Congratulations to our IRB Racing Team for their efforts at Fremantle on Saturday at the IRB State Championships our nine teams showed that Scarboro is still a force to be reckoned with in IRBs. With multiple teams making the finals we took out podium positions in every one of the nine events on the day, finishing second in the cumulative points score too. Having started training back in January for this event only for it to be cancelled due to COVID-19 the team have certainly had their eye on the long game and their efforts paid off on the weekend.

Saturday coming sees another round of surf sports as we head into the SunSmart WA Endurance Championships and WA Ironman Series at Sorrento SLSC. The surf boat leg of the Endurance Championships will commence at Scarboro so watch out for the flotilla as they head north to Sorrento starting at 10:15am.

We recently received notification from the City of Stirling of several break-ins at community sporting club buildings within the City of Stirling. During these break-ins, copper piping has been targeted from hot water systems leading to significant damage and associated safety risks.

All members are responsible for security around the Club, please ensure that when leaving the building it is fully secured. When leaving check all doors, windows and storage areas have been securely closed up. Our biggest weak point at present is the gym emergency exit and gym sliding glass doors being used and left unsecured, neither should be used for entry or exit purposes at any time.

Club members should also be vigilant when in and around club buildings for signs of abnormal activity. Please report any suspicious behaviour to the City's Community Safety team available 24/7 on 1300 365 356. Any criminal damage or criminal behaviour should also be reported to the Police immediately.

Would you like to give Surf League a crack?

We are looking to field a number of teams – we want to encourage participation and fun, so if you've wanted to give racing a crack, now is your time!

How does it work?

This year, SLSWA has introduced some exciting new changes, including a modified format to align with the new National Super Surf Teams League, reduced team sizes, and a standalone Youth (U14-U17) competition to showcase the up and coming stars of our sport. The SunSmart WA Surf League is a club based, team competition event – clubs may enter as many teams as they wish.

What are the Age Groups and Events?

This year we will have a Youth (U14-U17) event as well as an Open event.

Youth Events

- Male & Female Sprints, Flags, Board, Ski, Run/Swim/Run, & Ironman
- Male & Female Youth Ocean Relay (Run – 300m, Swim – 250m, Board – 350m, ski – 500m)

Open Events

- Male & Female Sprints, Flags, Board, Ski, Run/Swim/Run & Ironman
- Mixed 2 person board relay & ski relay
- Male & Female Ocean Relay (Run – 300m, Swim – 250m, Board – 350m, ski – 500m)

How are the teams made up?

Youth (U14-U17)

- 4 males & 4 females
- Minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 competitors
- Youth Teams may have a maximum of 4 x U/17's, but must have a minimum of 1 x U17 to complete the Ski event
- Iron will be swim and board only – no Ski
- U/17's may only race in either the Open or Youth competition, not both

Open

- 4 males & 4 females
- Open teams must have a minimum of 6 competitors and a maximum of 8 competitors.
- U/17's may only race in either the Open or Youth competition, not both.

Junior Water Safety ~ Simon Rushton

WATER SAFETY FOR SUNDAY CLUB ACTIVITIES

Each Sunday through the season, a driver and crew will be required from 8.15 am to 11.00 am to lay a swim line and/or buoys for the nipper's water arena (actual water arena set up will be dependent upon conditions), to provide water safety for all Club based activities from 8.30 am until approximately 10.30 am, and then pick up the swim line and/or buoys and bring them back to the beach. There will be a working party to unpack the gear trailer in the morning and to pack the trailer afterwards.

The Club is calling for a volunteers to fulfil this role. Each driver and crew will be permitted to sign on to Patrol on the Sunday morning with the hours spent undertaking water arena setup and water safety counting towards Patrol Hours.

The Club will run an introduction session for water arena set up as well as general water safety operation this Sunday 25 October 2020 as well as next Sunday, 1 November 2020 commencing at 8.00am. We encourage all those drivers and crews who are interested in helping out to please attend and add your name and telephone number to the Club Water Safety contact list.

Rather than a formal roster, the Club will send out a text message each Thursday to everyone on the Club Water Safety contact list calling for driver and crew volunteers for the coming Sunday's Club day.

This is a great way to learn more skills, and will enable you to help out when the Club has to provide water safety for carnivals to ensure we have the right number of officials/water safety personnel. This will allow all our competitors to compete. It is also a fun way to be more involved with Club water activities, even if you don't swim, paddle a board or ski or row a boat!
