Would you like to give Surf League a crack?

We are looking to field a number of teams – we want to encourage participation and fun, so if you've wanted to give racing a crack, now is your time!

How does it work?

This year, SLSWA has introduced some exciting new changes, including a modified format to align with the new National Super Surf Teams League, reduced team sizes, and a standalone Youth (U14-U17) competition to showcase the up and coming stars of our sport.

The SunSmart WA Surf League is a club based, team competition event – clubs may enter as many teams as they wish.

What are the Age Groups and Events?

This year we will have a Youth (U14-U17) event as well as an Open event.

Youth Events

- Male & Female Sprints, Flags, Board, Ski, Run/Swim/Run, & Ironman
- Male & Female Youth Ocean Relay (Run – 300m, Swim – 250m, Board – 350m, ski – 500m)

Open Events

- Male & Female Sprints, Flags, Board, Ski, Run/Swim/Run & Ironman
- Mixed 2 person board relay & ski relay
- Male & Female Ocean Relay (Run – 300m, Swim – 250m, Board – 350m, ski – 500m)

How are the teams made up?

Youth (U14-U17)

- 4 males & 4 females
- Minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 competitors
- Youth Teams may have a maximum of 4 x U/17's, but must have a minimum of 1 x U17 to complete the Ski event
- Iron will be swim and board only – no Ski
- U/17's may only race in either the Open or Youth competition, not both

Open

- 4 males & 4 females
- Open teams must have a minimum of 6 competitors and a maximum of 8 competitors.
- U/17's may only race in either the Open or Youth competition, not both.

Despite the weather we still had a great turnout (28 swimmers) for the second heat of the RJ Elliott Trophy. We started south of our usual swim cans and swam north, turned around and had the benefit of the current for the second leg. It meant a bit of a walk for everyone and there was a little complaining but at least Rosie and I had the benefit of the Jetski shelter - so I think it worked out rather well in the drizzling rain 😊 Thanks for your help Rosie it was great to have your assistance.

On the day Peter Tanham took out line honours, closely followed by Jennifer Mullins with Finn Knox, despite being the back marker again, recording the fastest time!

We had 17 swimmers eligible for the trophy having swum both heats - the 400m and 800m. Unfortunately for Finn, despite recording the fastest time in both heats, he is not yet eligible to complete his SRC, so misses out on the Trophy for fastest time. Next year you can claim the trophy Finn!

The trophy results were:

- **First on Handicap:** Tamara Nelson
- **Fastest:** Ben Johnson

And the trophy events keep coming.... this Sunday we have the **Kikiros Marathon**. The event is named after Andrew Kikiros who died attempting to save a swimmer at Esperance Beach. The trophy was donated in his honour by his family who were shop owners on the Scarborough Esplanade and were supporters of the surf club. The event is a multidisciplined marathon incorporating a 400m surf swim and 4km (approx.) beach run from Scarborough to Trigg and back. There are trophies for first on handicap and fastest time. So let's hope the rain stays away next week and I look forward to a great turnout.
