Officials Needed

A large part of Surf Lifesaving is volunteering. We manage to keep the fees low as we rely on volunteers in the Club to help provide the assistance needed.

Part of competition for Woodside Nippers and Seniors is being an Official. Surf Lifesaving will not let our Woodside Nippers compete unless we have 1 Official per 10 competitors, which means we need approx 5 Officials per age group. I completed my Officials course last year, and while it was an hour and 30 minutes I won't get back, I did learn a lot of interesting things like – if two kids grab the flag at the same time during flags, it's a run-off between the two children. Not the child who has the top or bottom hand, or the one who can rip it out of the other child's hand to give it back. It was a nice refresher on how to be a fair umpire/official.

We urgently need parents/caregivers/grandparents to sign up for this online course. Once you have completed it, we would like you officiate 1 Carnival per year. At the Carnival you will be asked to help usher kids to start line, write down names, make sure they finish over the line, and keep the area clear from spectators. Nothing too strenuous. You will also receive a little snack and refreshments while working and have the best view on the beach.
