On Sunday morning I met with the family of the young man who lost his life at Scarborough Beach the other week, and they asked me to pass on their thanks to our members for their ongoing support in looking for Matiyus, and the many members who when down at the beach and Club checked on the family whilst they waited on news. Sadly last Friday the police confirmed to us that remains of Matiyus had been found bringing to a close our recovery operation.

Friday 11 December will see our in-season Special General Meeting, notices of motion and the agenda for this meeting have been circulated to all voting members in advance. Due to our current capacity restrictions and the requirement for a quorum of over 80 members on the night, normal Friday Social Drinks will not be available, returning for our final sundowner on Friday 18 December. Drone Operators provide additional surveillance capabilities to our Lifesaving patrols using DJI Phantom 4 drones to watch over areas beyond the break.

To be eligible to join the program you will need to be at least 16 years of age and hold a lifesaving award (SRC, BM or First Aid).SLSWA provide all necessary training to get you up and running, also Drone patrols contribute to your annual patrol commitment.
