President’s Pen

Friday night saw our 2022 Annual General Meeting at the Club followed by a general members forum afterwards. Copies of the [Annual Report and Accounts](#) are available online for those who couldn’t make the night.

The 2021-22 season marked another successful season for the Club with strong membership growth driven by our Woodside Nippers, successful patrol operations, increased participation in surf sports, and a small financial surplus too. As we head towards 95 years of serving the community this season, we are in a strong position to continue growing and developing as a Club.

A number of administrative changes to the Club Constitution were voted through to comply with regulatory requirements on Friday night, along with two changes driven by the Club. The two key changes from a Club perspective were the permanent appointment to the Board of a “Member Development Director” following a one-year trial of this position as an appointment by the Board. This change supports our strategic priorities in the nipper, cadet and youth spaces and supports our members from U/6 through to their transition into open competition and active patrolling.

The second change was the removal of the mandatory mid-season General Meeting. Following two seasons of exceptionally low turnout at these meetings, the Board proposed to remove the mandatory requirement and retain the existing provisions that allow either the Board or the members to call for a General Meeting at any time. This proposal was put to the members present and voted to proceed with the removal of the mid-season General Meeting.

Congratulations to our four Directors who were elected unopposed for a further two-year term covering the 2022-23 & 2023-24 seasons, they are:

SRC to Bronze Medallion Course 1-7 October

An upskill course for SRC to Bronze Medallion is available to those candidates wishing to upgrade their SRC to Bronze Medallion in the Term 3 school holidays. The course will commence on Saturday 1 October at 4.30pm with the timed 400 metre swim at Scarborough pool, then continue Monday 3 October through until Friday 7 October from 0800-1200 each day.

This course is only available to the first 18 candidates who apply and who meet the following criteria:

- Turn 15 or older on or before Friday 7 October
- Hold a current/proficient Surf Rescue Certificate award
- Are able to swim 400 metres in the pool in 9 minutes or less (due to the short duration of this course there will be no time for candidates to improve their swimming skills if they cannot swim 400 metres in less than 9 minutes on the 1st October)
- MUST have completed the online learning IN FULL prior to course commencement and submit the online completion certificate as proof to educationofficer@scarboro.com.au by 30 September
- Attend EVERY session of the course duration - if you are away on holidays for part of the course you cannot complete the SRC to Bronze Medallion school holiday program.
- Pay the course participation fee of \$60 via the member portal prior to course commencement.

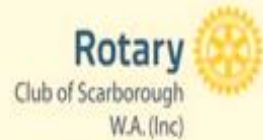
