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## 1. Introduction

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All Clubs entering members in major interclub carnivals and other surf sports events are required to provide accredited surf sports officials to officiate at these events. This includes Junior, Senior and Country Carnivals as well as the Senior, Masters, Junior and all other State Championship carnivals and events. From time to time SLSWA will circulate details of the minimum required number of officials from each Club in order for that Club to enter members.

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## 2. Objectives

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The objectives of this document are to;

- Ensure that Scarborough SLSC has sufficient accredited Surf Sports Officials to fulfil its Competition requirements.
  - Ensure that Scarborough SLSC members are able to compete in carnivals and surf sports events.
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## 3. Definitions

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Carnivals – Surf Sports events, inclusive of local area carnivals, qualifying carnivals and State Championships

Club Member – The member and/or their parents/guardian (where applicable)

Competition Official – Person who has achieved accreditation by attending a SLSWA Officials course

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## 4. Surf Sports Competition Officials Requirements

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The Director Surf Sports is responsible for ensuring the Club has the required number of accredited surf sports competition officials to meet the Club's quota as may be set annually by SLSWA in order for the Club to enter members in the many and various surf sports carnivals, events and championships conducted in each year.

From time to time SLSWA will circulate details of the required number of accredited officials each Club must have attend to enable their Club to enter members into the various events and competitions.

Club members are encouraged to gain accreditation as surf sports officials in order for the Club to provide as many officials as are required from event to event.
