This weekend sees another round of surf sports competition with the Master State Titles being held up at Mullaloo SLSC on Saturday over the long weekend. We have an increased contingent of Masters competitors making an appearance this year as the event returns to the metro area after a trip to Denmark last season.

I have recently been notified by WA Police of a concerning incident around our Club and we are assisting them with their investigation.

Although we have CCTV and an access control system in operation it is only as good as our members ensuring that they are vigilant too when in and around the Club. We ask that our members do the following to ensure that the Club and our members remain safe:

- Be wary of persons tailgating you into the Club, if you don't recognise them ask, they should have their fob-band to hand.
- Ensure all doors close securely behind you and are not propped or wedged open for convenience.
- Secure all personal valuables in the lockers provided, do not leave them lying around.
- Close gear shed roller doors whilst out on boards, skis and boats, remove the temptation from sight as people walk by.

SURF SPORTS DIRECTOR – Dana de Bondt

A friendly reminder that as we come to the pointy end of the season (and IRBs are about to start), it is important to ensure that all members have paid their season competition levy if they have been competing this 2020/21 summer season and/or intend on competing in winter events, such as IRB racing in 2021. The office will run a report on Friday 5th March, and all members who have competed in carnivals this season and not yet paid, will be invoiced by the club.

2021 Fee Structure:

Open/Masters - \$60 or \$20 per Carnival (You may only compete in 1 carnival)

U/14-U19 - \$50

Junior (< U/13) - \$30 or \$10 per carnival

This will cover athletes who attend all regular carnivals, surf league, etc.

The competitions that are not covered are **CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS** (State Titles & Australian Titles). These are to be paid online no later than a week prior to the event itself.
