## CONSTITUTION POLICY – Bob Welch

### New Policy, Policy Update

**Policy 1.0 Member Protection.** New policy. Approved for circulation at Board meeting 13/10/21, this policy will assist in ensuring that members are aware of the Club's procedures and guidelines in dealing with any matter of concern by a member regarding discrimination, bullying, harassment or abuse in any form deemed unacceptable by the member affected. In accordance with the Constitution clause 25.1, the draft policy has been available for comment from members in excess of 21 days and will now be adopted by the Board at its next meeting.

**Policy 7.8 Club Colours and badge.** New policy. Approved for circulation at Board meeting 15/2/21, this policy will introduce members to the official colours of the club and use of the official club badge. In accordance with the Constitution clause 25.1, the draft policy will now be made available on the club website for comment from members before being adopted by the Board at a future meeting.

**Policy 2.2 Patrol Requirements.** Amended policy. Approved for circulation at Board meeting 10/11/20 and indicated in Echo edition 671, this amendment deleted the minimum 4 hour patrol requirement for Long Service Members.

The original policy is still listed on the website and will now be replaced by the updated policy once adopted by the Board at its next meeting.

Policy 6.2 Service of Alcohol. Amended Policy. Approved for circulation at Board meeting 13/10/20, this amendment is an update of the policy to suit recent changes to the Liquor Control Act. The updated policy will shortly be listed on the Club website for the information of members before being adopted by the Board at a future meeting.
