AGM: Requirement For Member Protection Credentials 2021/2022

Dear Members.

The Board of Directors has determined that any member standing for a leadership position involving the management, supervision or coaching of children should have member protection credentials in place **prior to** the Club's Annual General Meeting on 2nd July 2021.

Directors:

Members nominating for the position of Director are required to have their credentials in place prior to submitting their Nomination Form. Receipt numbers **will not** suffice.

Office-bearers:

Members nominating for an Office-bearer position are required to have initiated the process of applying for their credentials. Receipt numbers of an application **will** suffice in the Nomination Form. Nominees will be required to provide the full credentials as soon as they are in receipt of the same.

Endorsement:

The Board of Directors will not endorse appointment to any of the below credentialed positions until such time as full credentials are in place. Pleasingly, the vast majority of members involved in member credentialed positions in the past 12 months are already qualified, should they decide to stand again.
